Thank you for your interest in participating in the 2026 parade. Here are a few important things to know about the upcoming parade.

2025 COST OF ENTERING PARADE:

Non-profit groups: \$25 THROUGH *June 16*, \$75 BEGINNING *June 17*.

Businesses: \$100 THROUGH *June 16*, \$150 BEGINNING *June 17*.

Registration deadline is *July 16*

Date of Parade: August 2, 2026

Tractor Trailer/Flat Bed Line Up: 2:00 p.m.

Entry Line Up: Starts at 2:30 p.m.

Time of Parade: 4:00 p.m.

Judging in Staging Area at 3:00 p.m.

Tram will pick up every 15 minutes: 2:30pm, 2:45pm, 3:00pm & 3:15pm

Mandatory Participant & Number Pick-Up Meeting: Tuesday, July 21st @ 6:00 p.m. at the Farmers Market. A representative from your group **MUST ATTEND**. Groups not represented will be dropped from the parade! Please mark your calendar now to have someone attend.

To add to the quality of the parade, all participants are required to have decoration on their entries. Judging of floats will be based on the fair theme of “Rooted in Tradition.”

As in the past, **NO POLITICAL ENTRIES OF ANY KIND WILL BE ALLOWED IN THE PARADE**. Anyone displaying political propaganda will be asked to remove it. This includes clothing. If person does not comply, they will be removed from the parade. A complete copy of the rules is attached. Please read over them and review with your group prior to the parade. There will be no refunds or rescheduled date if the parade is rained out.

Floats have the opportunity to be judged. If you would like your float to be judged, please indicate this on the entry form. Prizes will be awarded as follows 1st place- \$225.00, 2nd place- \$175.00, and 3rd place- \$125.00.

Judging will take place BEFORE the parade begins, at 3:00 p.m. in Lot 1.

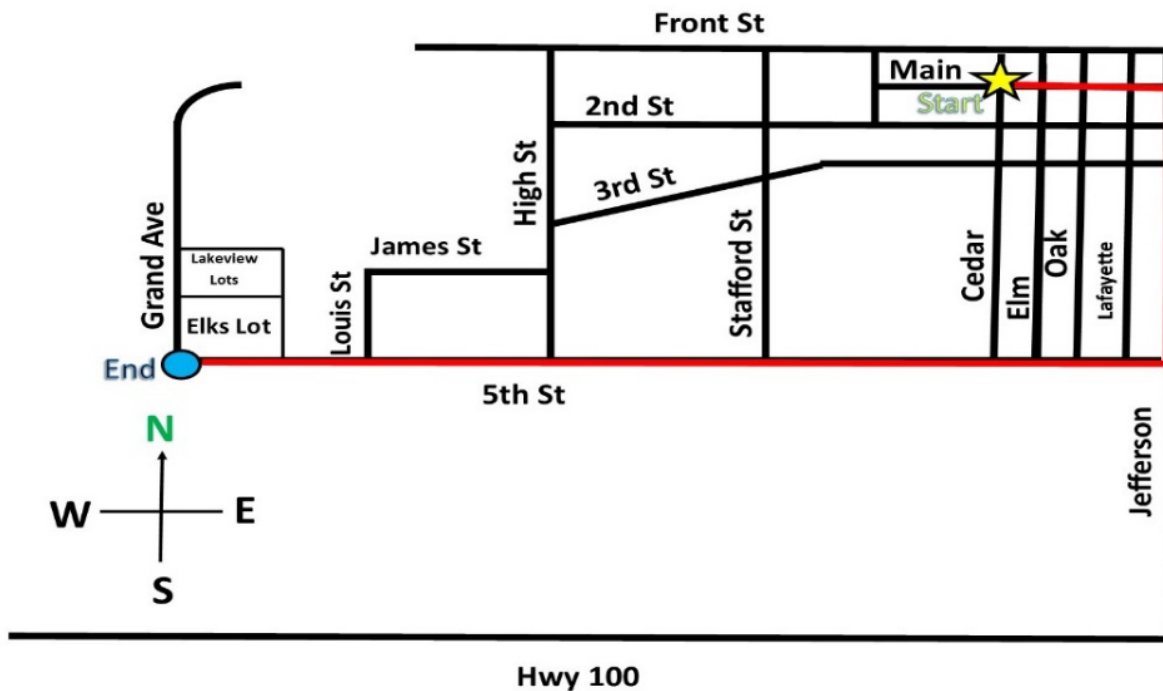

PARADE ROUTE – Ending at Grand & 5th

The parade begins at Main and Cedar Streets. The parade will travel East on Main. Then travel South on Jefferson. Next the parade will travel West on 5th Street to Grand. The parade will end at Grand and 5th St where parade officials will direct entries down Grand to the fairgrounds.
